A LITTLE NOTE FOR GROWN-UPS: Reading together helps to build language, imagination and creates beautiful bonding moments that children carry forever.

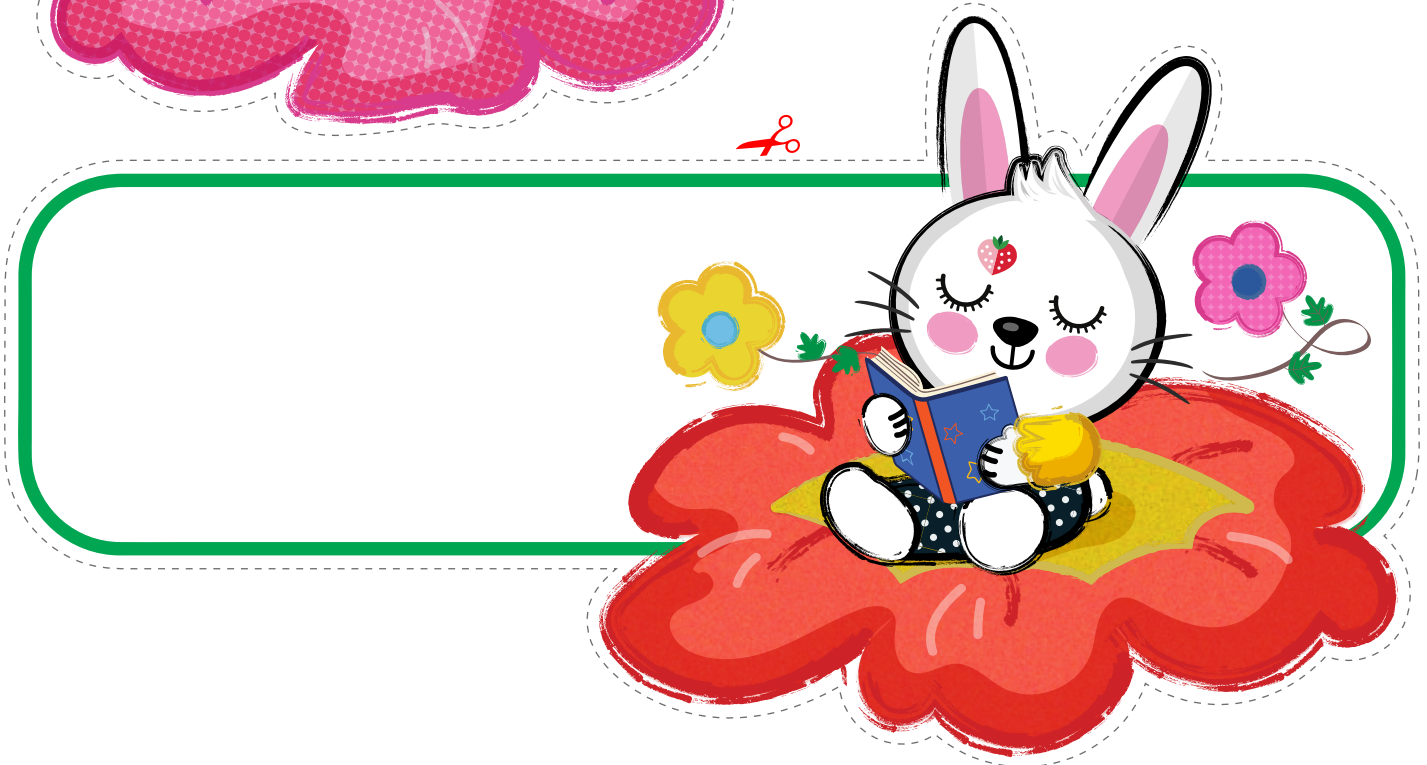
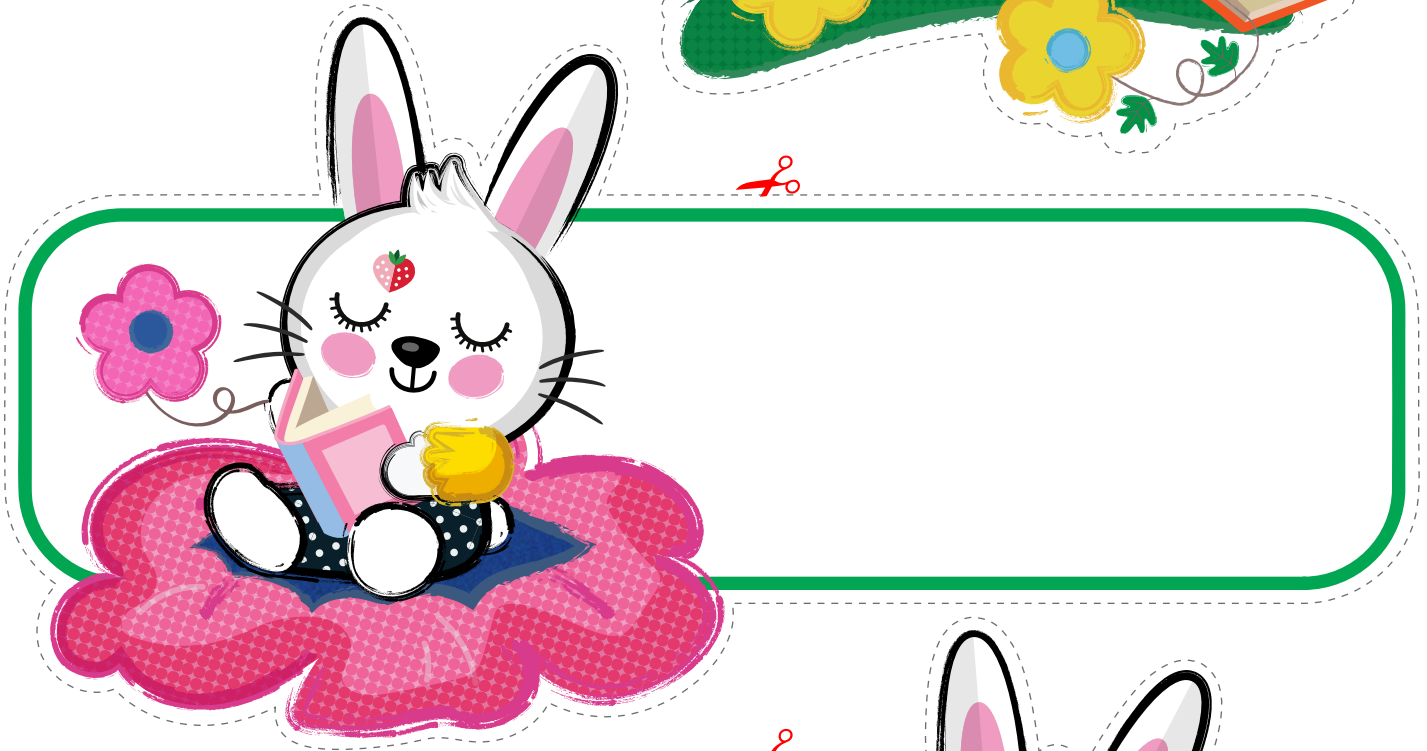
BOOK BUDDY PROMISE

COSTUME IDEAS

Encourage children to come dressed as pirates. We suggest you pair our Pirate Hat with a stripy t-shirt and shorts or rolled up trousers (and a waistcoat if you have one). A scarf tied around the waist would finish off the look nicely too!

ACTIVITY IDEAS

★ BUILD A SHIP

Build a pirate ship from cardboard boxes. You could make a small one for your child's toys to ride in or one large enough for the children to fit inside. Can you make one that looks as colourful as Captain Alice's? Discuss the different parts of a pirate ship and how they helped the crew work together to sail.

★ DECORATE FLAGS

Making pirate flags is a fun craft that can be done with whatever you have. Draw them on paper and colour with pencils or crayons; cut out fabric or felt pieces.

★ READ TOGETHER

Read When Alice Sleeps: Treasure Map together; then talk about your favourite parts of the story and why you liked them.

★ LET'S PLAY PIRATE BINGO

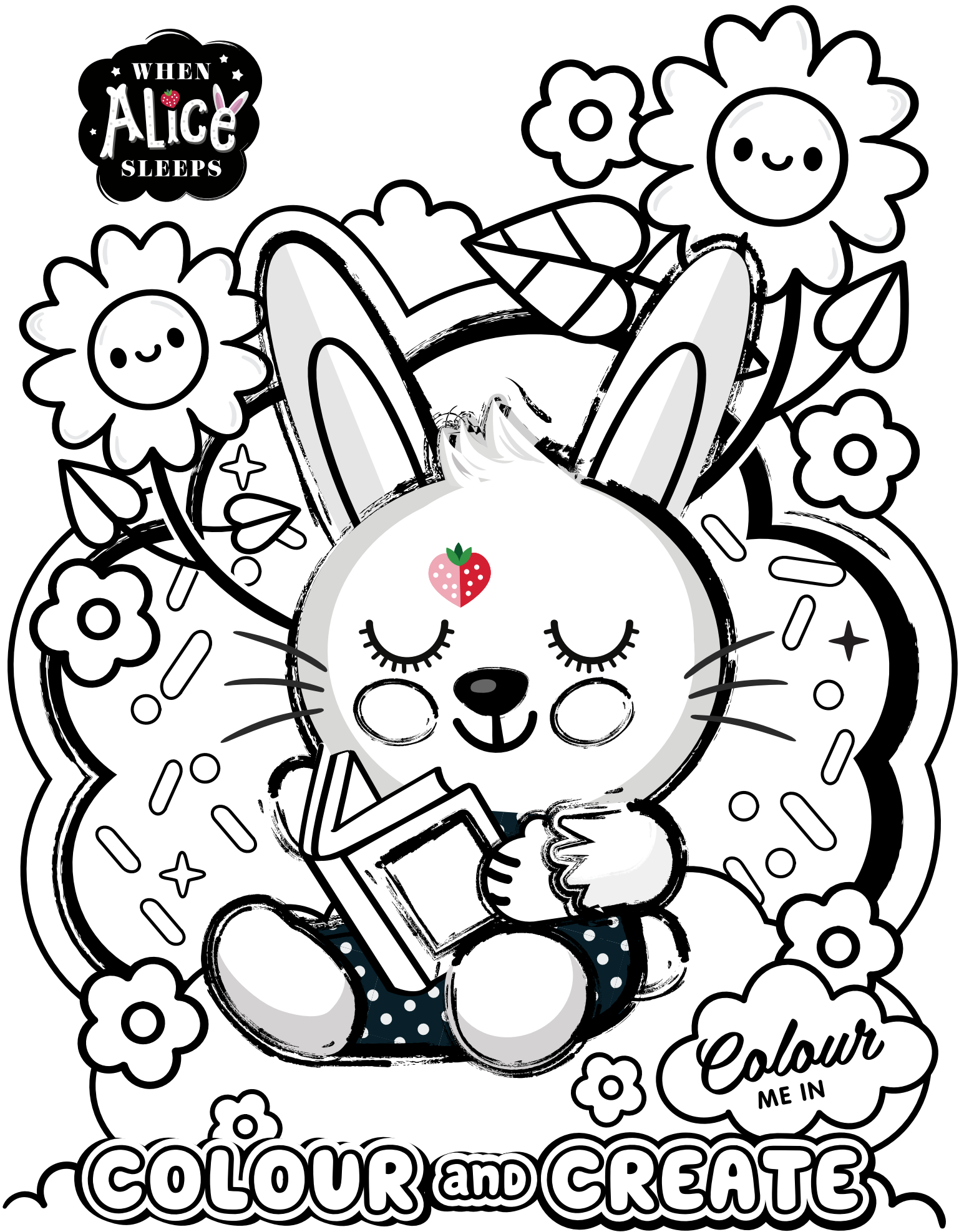

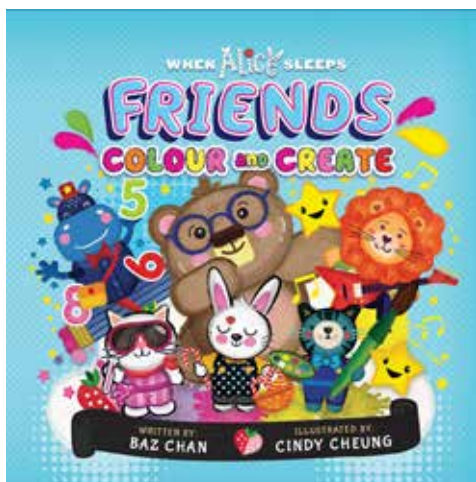
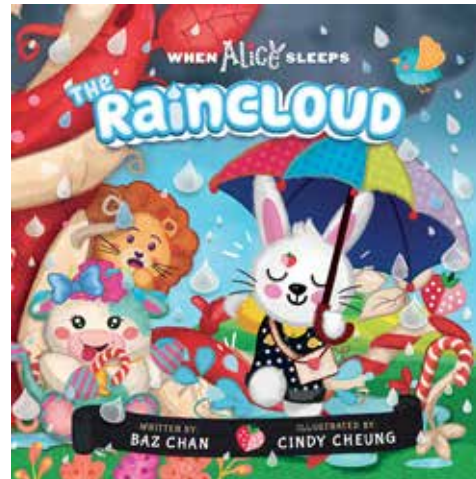
