

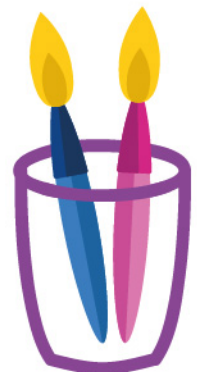
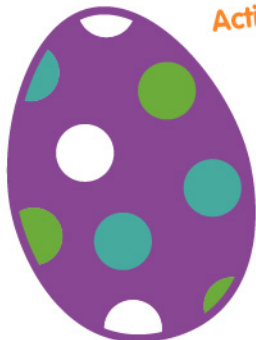

ALICE BUNNY POP-UP CARD

Create your own friendly Alice Bunny pop-up card, a wonderful Easter craft idea for your kids.

What you need:

- Alice Bunny pop-up card printable template
- Green card/or thick paper (other colours are fine too)
- print paper (regular or heavy)
 - scissors
 - glue

Step by Step Instructions

1. Print off the Alice Bunny pop-up card template in "High Quality" onto white premium paper stock.

2. Cut out the parts according to the instructions on the template and fold them as marked. The card is folded with the printed side facing in.

3. Alice Bunny and the band is to be folded in half with the printed side facing out. Alice Bunny's legs are folded with the printed side facing in.

4. Cut a coloured card/or paper to fit the printed card template onto and fold it in half.

5. Glue the legs over the grey area on the printed card template. Then do the same with the band. Finally, glue the printed card on to the coloured card/or paper.

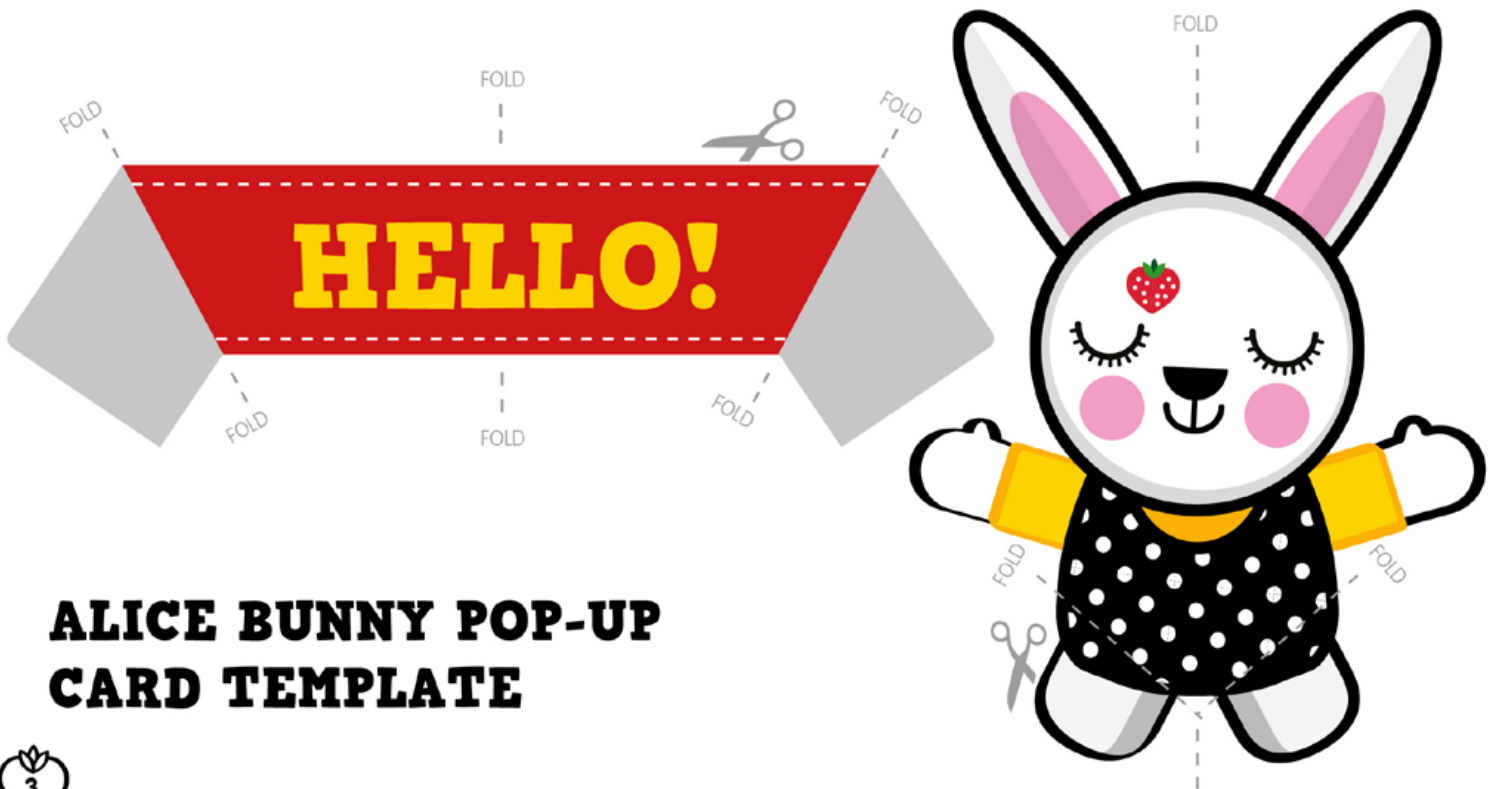
6. All done!
Your Alice Bunny pop-up card is complete.

ALICE BUNNY POP-UP CARD TEMPLATE

CHICK POP-UP CARD

Create your own friendly chick pop-up card, a wonderful Easter craft idea for your kids.

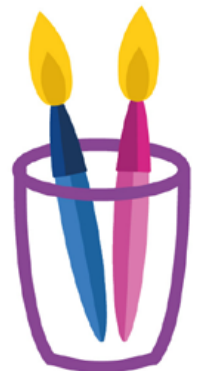


What you need:

- Chick pop-up card printable template
- red card (other colours are fine too)
- print paper (regular or heavy)
- scissors
- glue
- colouring supplies if you printed the black and white template

Step by Step Instructions

- 1.** Print out the Chick Pop-up Card Template. If you printed the black and white one, have the kids colour in the chick.
- 2.** Cut out the template – cut along the outer line (rectangle).
- 3.** There is a dashed line running across the template – fold along that dashed line (with the design on the outside).
- 4.** Now let's take a look at the straight line in the middle of the beak. Cut along that line.
- 5.** There are two diagonal dashed lines going along the beak, fold along those lines. Make the folds nice and crisp.
- 6.** Now open up the card. Push your fingers (from the back) through the beak and slowly start closing the card. (Run your fingers across the folds to make them crisper).
- 7.** Stick the folded card onto coloured card. One side, first... Then apply glue on the other side (of the template) and close the card and wait for the glue to set.
- 8. All done!**
Your Chick pop-up card is complete.

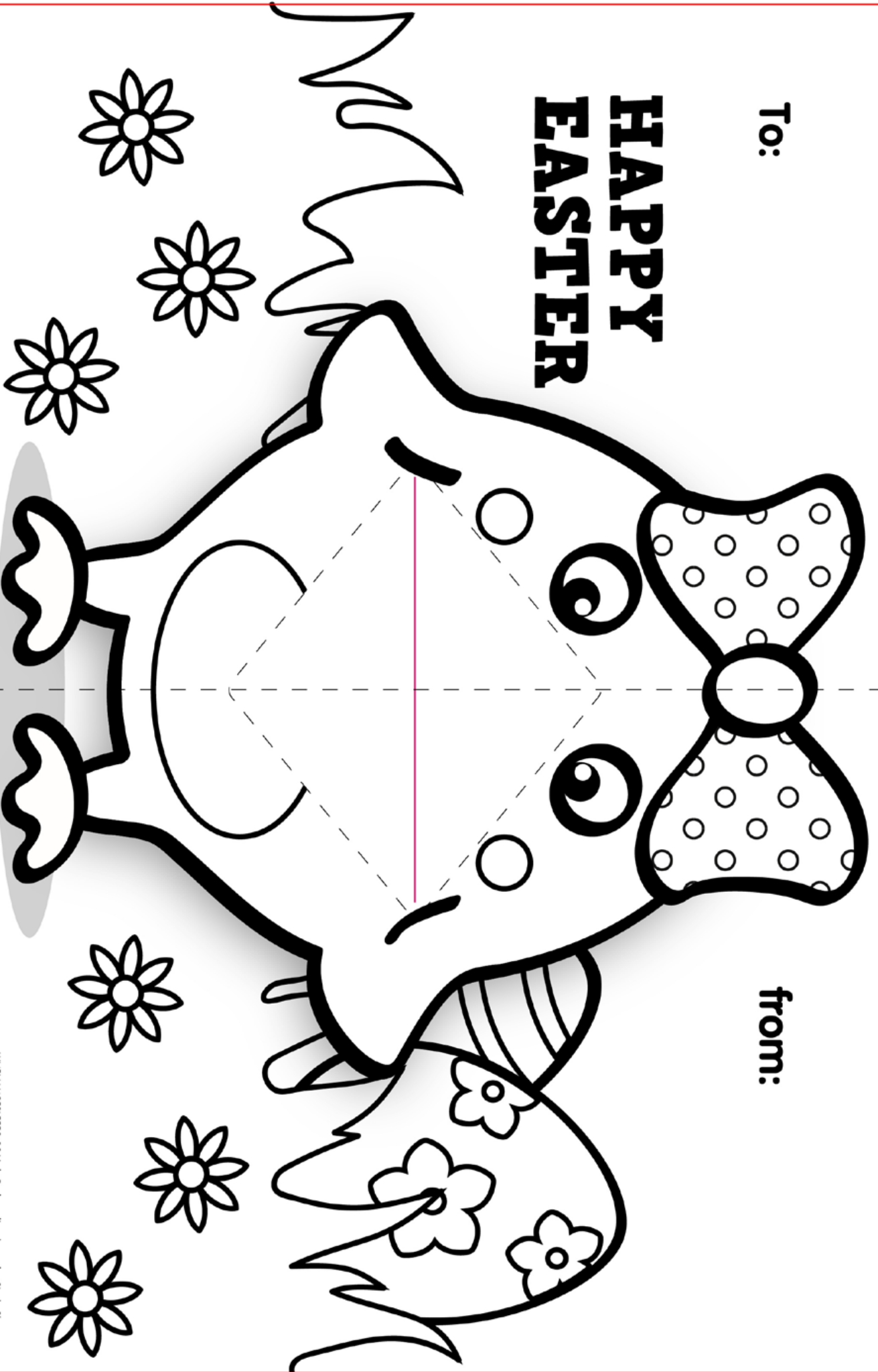

BUNNY BREAD ROLLS

These adorable bunny bread rolls are sure to be a hit with the whole family!

Ingredients

400g strong bread flour
25g margarine
70g caster sugar
½ tsp salt
7g fast action dry yeast
200g warm water

Finishing:

1 x beaten egg for egg wash
50g Dark Chocolate (melted)
Piping Bag

Instructions

1. Sift the flour into a large mixing bowl, rub the margarine into the flour. Add the sugar, salt and yeast and make a well in the centre. Pour in the water and bring together with your hands to make a soft dough. Remove from the bowl and knead for 10 minutes, until springy and elastic.
2. Cover the mixing bowl with a clean damp tea towel. Place in a warm, humid environment and allow to rise for 1.5 hours for the dough to double in size.
3. Working quickly, divide the dough into eight equal portions and roll 6 of them into balls and place on a greaseproof paper lined baking tray.
4. Cut the 2 remaining pieces into 6 (12 total) and then shape them into bunny ears and add to the dough balls.
5. Leave to rise, covered with greased cling film, for another 30 minutes until doubled in size.
6. Pre-heat oven to 190C/170Fan/GM 5.
7. Brush with the beaten egg and then bake for about 20 minutes until golden brown.
8. Once your bunnies are completely cooled, draw faces on using the melted dark chocolate.



Tip: The dough will start to prove as you're assembling your bunnies, so it's best to do this quickly to stop them rising and losing their shape.

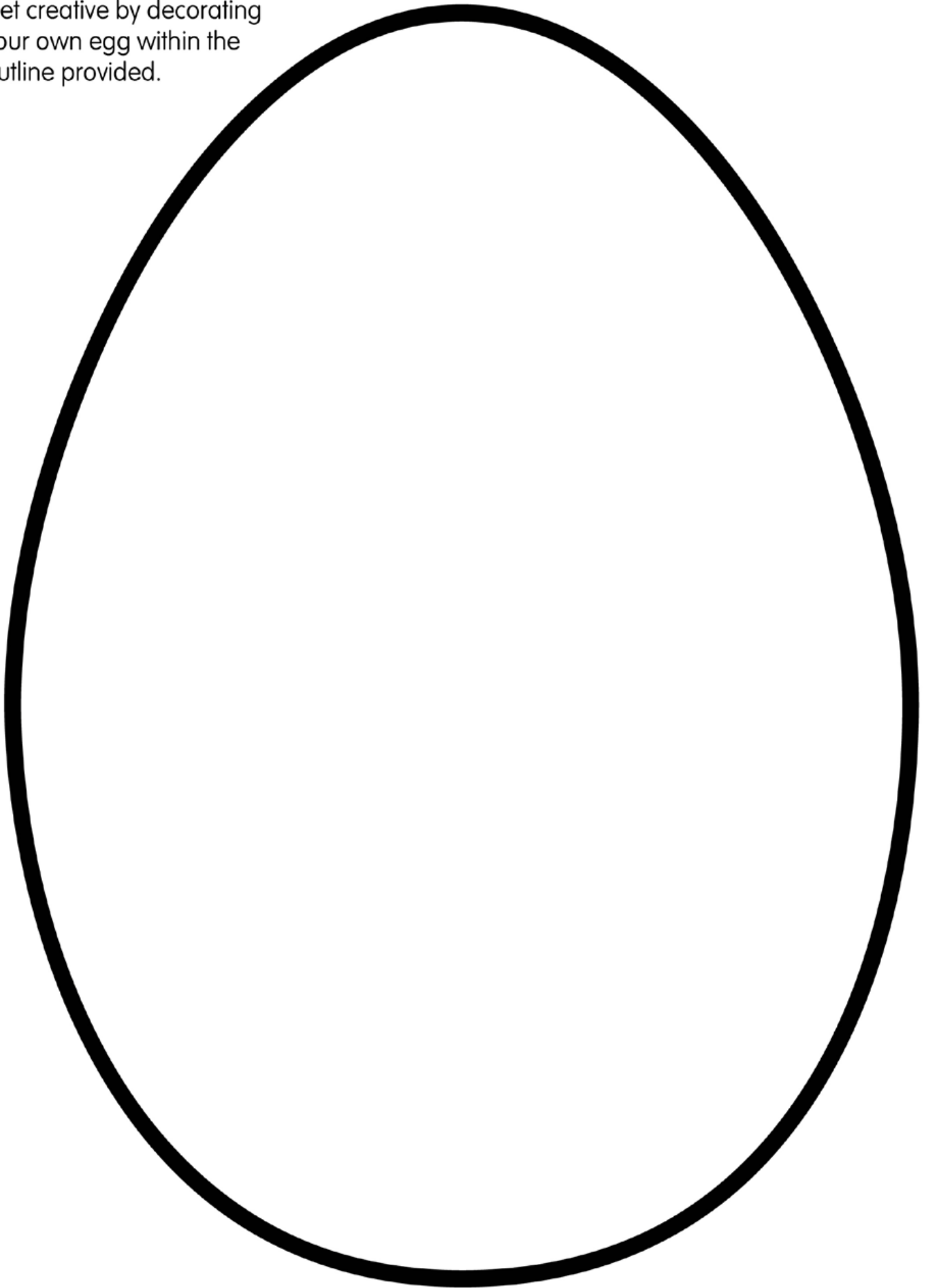
